GENERAL STATEMENT OF POSITION:

The Intake Assistant is responsible for processing clients applications, data, filing and all administrative duties for Intake Workers. In addition to making initial referrals appropriate to client's needs and advising ineligible clients of other resources and their right to appeal

REPORTS TO: Intake Worker

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provides group information and referral sessions in perspective applicants.
- Receives and reviews application package to ensure application is complete.
- Schedule meeting with applicant upon completion of the file being reviewed.
- Meets with applicants to review all available information, explain the purpose of the Intake Interview.
- Inform clients of resources, both internal and external, and how to access such resources.
- Completes all necessary intake documents and verifies.
- Inform clients of what is expected of them throughout the process.
- Inform applicants of the services available to them from other on-reserve programs, federal and provincial programs and other external agencies.
- Works closely with the Social Workers as part of the Siksika Family Services Corporate team.
